


Altan's Dachshunds Puppy Application

Thank you for considering a puppy from Altan's Dachshunds.

Our puppies' future wellbeing and life quality are extremely important to us, and that's why we have implemented a screening procedure in order to select the best homes for them. In the world of purebred dogs, demand exceeds supply, and it allows us to be selective when picking homes for our babies. Every one of our puppy owners is nothing short of wonderful. Hopefully, you too will soon join our happy family!

Step 1 APPLICATION	All potential puppy owners fill out this application form . Upon reviewing, we will either approve or deny it , or inform you that we need additional information before making a decision. Follow-up questions are common. If we need more information, you may be invited for a meeting, a phone interview, asked for references, or for a home visit.
Step 2 WAITING LIST	Those families who complete the screening successfully are invited to join our waiting list for either a current or an upcoming litter. Non-refundable waiting list fee of \$100 is paid at this time , to be deducted from the puppy's purchase price. Now the waiting begins, sweetened by pictures and videos of the puppies as they grow.
Step 3 PUPPY EVALUATION	Between the ages of 7 and 9 weeks our puppies undergo a rigorous evaluation and grading session . It includes a detailed conformation assessment, a variety of professional temperament tests, and a vet visit with an unaffiliated veterinarian.
Step 4 DECISION MAKING	Once the evaluation and grading are complete, we work to see whether any of the puppies match the requirements of any of the families on the waiting list. This is the most crucial step of the process, and we take our responsibility to match the right puppy to the right home very seriously. We never allow choosing puppies from pictures, as they are only skin deep! Puppy's inborn temperament is much more important than his color or the length of his eyelashes in ensuring a lifelong happy placement.
Step 5 THE OFFER	Soon after making decisions, we will contact you with an offer of a particular puppy. An offer includes photos and puppy's resume. Occasionally we are able to offer two puppies to choose from. We pay tremendous attention to personalities and temperaments of our puppies and go above and beyond to ensure a perfect match with their new families. At this point you have 24 hours to either accept or decline the chosen puppy.
Step 6 HOLDING FEE	A non-refundable deposit of \$400 secures the puppy from the day the offer is accepted to the day of pick up. Remaining balance is paid in cash on pickup day.
Step 7 TAKING PUPPY HOME	After the sales contract is signed and the puppy is paid for, you become a proud puppy owner. Arrangements are made for pick up or delivery. We have placed puppies worldwide and are well experienced in every little detail that makes for a successful trip, be it a one hour drive or a two days long flight. Generally, puppies are expected to be transferred to new homes after 8 but before 10 weeks of age to avoid boarding fees. MARCH'2020 UPDATE: during coronavirus pandemic, no visits are possible, all meetings, including puppy pickups, are to be done off premises while donning masks and gloves. This is for everyone's protection. Our house is off limits until the coronavirus threat passes.

Pay attention to pet age limits for your chosen airline. Purchase a soft sided pet carrier to transport the puppy in cabin with you.

Useful Information:

Puppy visits are no longer available at Altan's until the pickup day due to disease risk.

We maintain strict biosecurity regimen in the house to protect our young puppies. Meeting our adults is always possible off-site (at a park, a cafe, or a pet store), as well as at dog shows in the South East. We are proud to show off our beautiful dogs. Contact us to arrange a meeting.

Our puppies are raised holistically with no expense spared.

Fresh high quality organic food, spring water, plenty of sunshine and clean air, no routine antibiotics, no overvaccination, no harsh chemicals anywhere around our dogs. We find that raising puppies this way ensures a healthy immune system and a long life. We expect you to educate yourself on holistic dog maintenance and to continue with it. As recent European transplants ourselves, we keep true to the way we had raised dogs back home, for enhanced vitality and health. We are always available to help you learn the best practices. You are not just buying a puppy, you're gaining access to a breeder/veterinarian, an experienced professional advisor on any dog question you might ever possibly have, today, tomorrow, or ten years from now.

Unlike most breeders, we do not demand spay/neuter in our contract

We encourage you to do your research on the harmful side effects of spay and neuter in dogs in general and in Dachshund breed in particular. Mother Nature does not create unnecessary organs. *We would prefer all our puppies be kept intact for life,* and in no case should they be castrated before the age of 24 months. Failing to follow this guideline will cancel the health guarantee.

We do not remove front dewclaws

Coming from working dog background, we firmly believe that dewclaws serve a purpose and that removing them alters the gait of the dog, leading to a higher frequency of orthopedic problems as dogs age.

We will always take back one of ours if they no longer can stay in their home.

No Altan's puppy has ever entered a rescue or a shelter, and we intend to keep this stellar statistic. We are here for our puppies from birth to grave. If you're incapacitated, you always have us to make sure your dog is taken care of.

We are always happy to welcome newcomers to the Dog Show World.

We occasionally place some of our show prospect puppies in coownership to pet homes that are local and wish to learn about dog shows. This is a great way to give back to the Dachshund breed and ensure its preservation for future generations, and it's a lot of fun too! Maybe a new weekend hobby for you and/or the kids? If you're a local home, chat to us about showing your new puppy. We will help and support you every step of the way. Give back to this wonderful breed, don't just take from it! *Limited to homes in NC, SC, and VA, unless professional handler is contracted.*

Our puppies placed as family pets are placed on LIMITED AKC registration and are NOT meant for breeding!

We do not support uneducated, random breeding of dogs. Please leave it to the professionals to produce the next generation of wonderful Dachshunds. If you're buying a family pet from us, it is not a breeding prospect.

We are frequently asked why most of our dogs have been imported.

Why go through the tremendous expense and trouble getting and transporting a stud dog from Europe, when there are many of them right here in the US? *The reason is quality.* European breeders operate under a much stricter system that includes close oversight by breed wardens. European breeders health test and only use the best for breeding. This system was put in place long time ago to ensure continuous breed improvement. There is a lot more science and a lot less amateur approach that goes into producing a litter in Europe. We have worked for years to gain contacts and trust from European Dachshund breeders to be able to bring these amazing Dachshunds into the US and share them with the breed fanciers here. You have to meet them to appreciate the difference!

Should you care to buy from a small show breeder as opposed to a large commercial breeder?

You absolutely should! Show breeders are concerned about the breed as a whole and individual welfare of each of their dogs and puppies. Commercial breeders are only concerned about their bottom line and cut corners, from quality of the parents and bloodlines, to the food they feed and veterinary care they provide. By buying a cheap randomly bred puppy, you're supporting a greedy, unethical approach to dog breeding and poor quality care of the parent dogs. Choose to support a breeder who pours their heart and soul into their carefully created breeding program. Don't settle for a second-hand bicycle when you can have a Ferrari. Your show bred dog will have a beautiful posture and elegance, correct healthy structure and breed type, excellent immunity and top notch temperament and intelligence. This is a dog who will grace your life for 15-18 years, would you rather share your home with a living breathing work of art, or a run of the mill mass produced product?
